Medical Appraisal – Extension of "Approved Missed"

Thank you for your support and exceptional work during these unique times. I am writing to confirm the position on the provision of medical appraisal in Wales.

In recognition of the increasing pressures on the service, the option for an 'approved missed' appraisal period will be extended to the end of March 2021. Many may find it beneficial to continue with a supportive appraisal, however, those that wish to decline the option of an appraisal will receive an 'approved missed'. An approved missed appraisal postpones the process for 12 months.

We have always placed great value on the appraisal process in Wales and recognise the value of appraisal in supporting the profession. The availability of a wellbeing and supportive appraisal remains to those who still wish to access an appraisal discussion at this time. Many have taken advantage of such appraisals in recent months and the feedback that we have received is that they have been of significant value. In these circumstances an appraisal discussion can take place with minimal supporting information, with a focus on wellbeing and any changes to practice as a result of the pandemic.
